STUDENT SUPPLIES:

- 2 or 3 full newspapers
- 2 rolls of thin masking tape
- 2 cereal boxes (or similarly thin cardboard)
- Pencil
- Markers
- Glue (stick or liquid)
- Scissors
- 10 chopsticks (or other similar items to use as rods)
- 2 mismatched socks (clean)
- String
- Permanent marker or laundry marker (recommended)
- Scraps of fabric, buttons, yarn, ribbon, felt, etc.
- A large bead or washer or nut
- Your choice of: large paper cup (recommended), juice carton, milk carton, water bottle, or similar.
MUST BE CLEAN AND HAVE NO SHARP EDGES!
- Plastic shopping bag in any color (will be used for hair)
- 1 or 2 square feet of light fabric. This can come from old clothes such as t-shirts, or old sheets etc. Simple colors without patterns work best.
- Cardboard box at least 2'x2' or 2 sheets of foam core from old school projects
- Large white plastic bag or old white shower curtain
- Large paper grocery bag
- Duct tape or wide masking tape
