STUDENT SUPPLIES:

*Bringing your canvas to life will be made possible through weekly classes which will explore expression in the **medium of the student's choice**. Classical music will be played to enhance the student to arrive in an awareness of what it means to be a fine artist. Basic skills of the elements and principles of design as well as color theory will be an ongoing study throughout the six week course.*

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES ARE CURRENTLY IN STOCK AT PAT CATANS/CHARTIERS AVENUE. Please ask for a clerk's help if needed!

- **PAINT** (Acrylic/Oil/Choice of student):
CADMIUM YELLOW PALE (LIGHT), CADMIUM YELLOW (DEEP), CADMIUM RED LIGHT, ALIZARIN CRIMSON, DIOXAZINE PURPLE, ULTRAMARINE BLUE, COBALT BLUE, EMERALD GREEN, PHTHALO GREEN, TITANIUM WHITE, BURNT SIENNA, MARS BLACK
(If desired, economically priced 50 cent bottles of the same color ACRYLIC paint may be purchased. If purchasing bottles, you must match the color of the named paint sold in tubes. You can do this simply by holding the named tube of paint in one hand, walking over to the section of the store where the bottles are sold, hold the correct color NEXT TO the bottle when matching it with the bottled paint.) It is extremely important to purchase the named colors above!
- **Small sketch book/pad**
- **+ Any drawing supplies desired: pencil, pen, marker, charcoal, kneaded eraser, etc.**
- **Paint brushes: #10 flat, #4 flat, and # 4 round**
- **Palette** (Various types are sold in stores; the most useful palette is large enough to accommodate mixing including a lid to eliminate waste by drying; any household flat pan lined with wax paper may be used.)
- **Canvas or canvas boards/arches papers;** surfaces to accommodate your chosen medium, 16 x 20 inch or larger. One or more may be used, it's the choice of student
- **Painting knives** (flexible). Painting knives have an arched handle
- **One or two large plastic containers** to hold water and to clean brushes (empty cans/jars from home will do.)
- **Clean rags or paper towels** (To clean brushes, etc.)
- **Odorless Turpentine and Linseed Oil** (For students using oil paints)
- **Folder** (to hold class hand-out sheets and student information)
- **A Roll of Masking tape**
